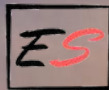

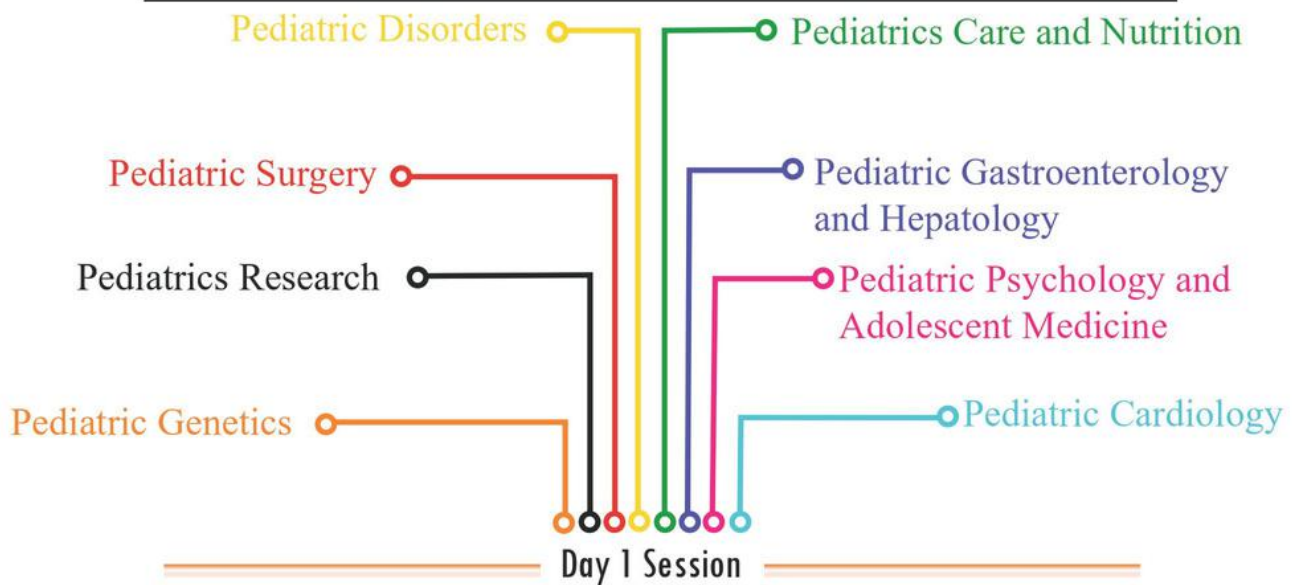

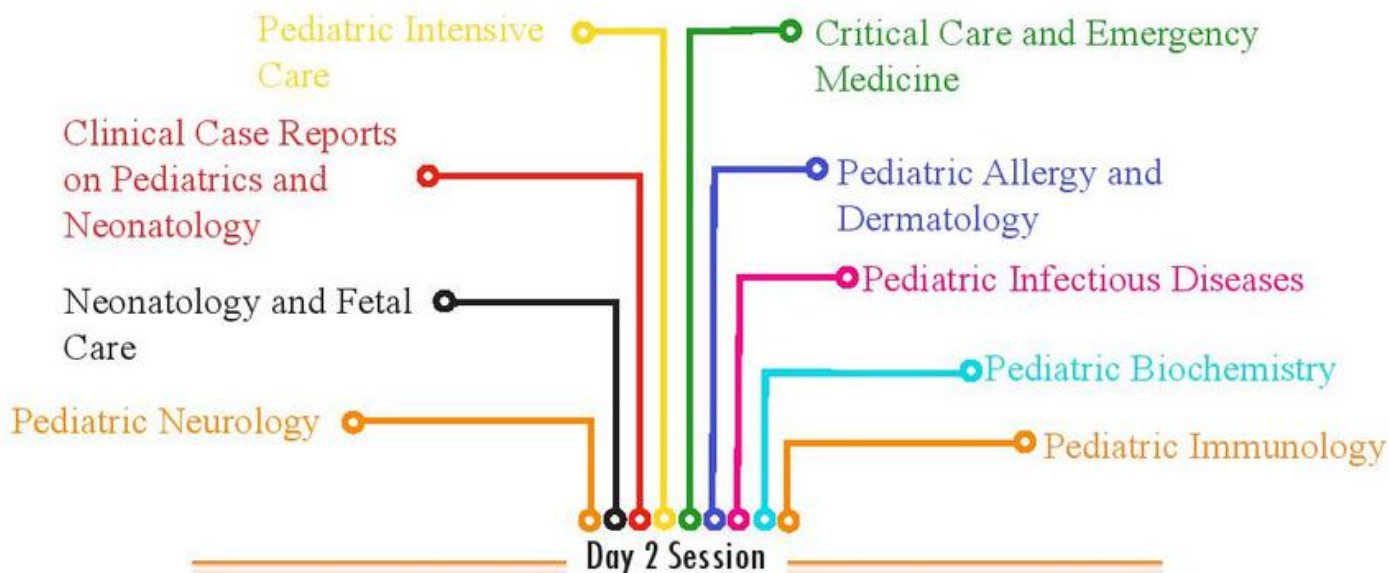

*Please note that abstracts must be SUBMITTED before the deadline in order to be sent to review for inclusion in the Scientific Program.

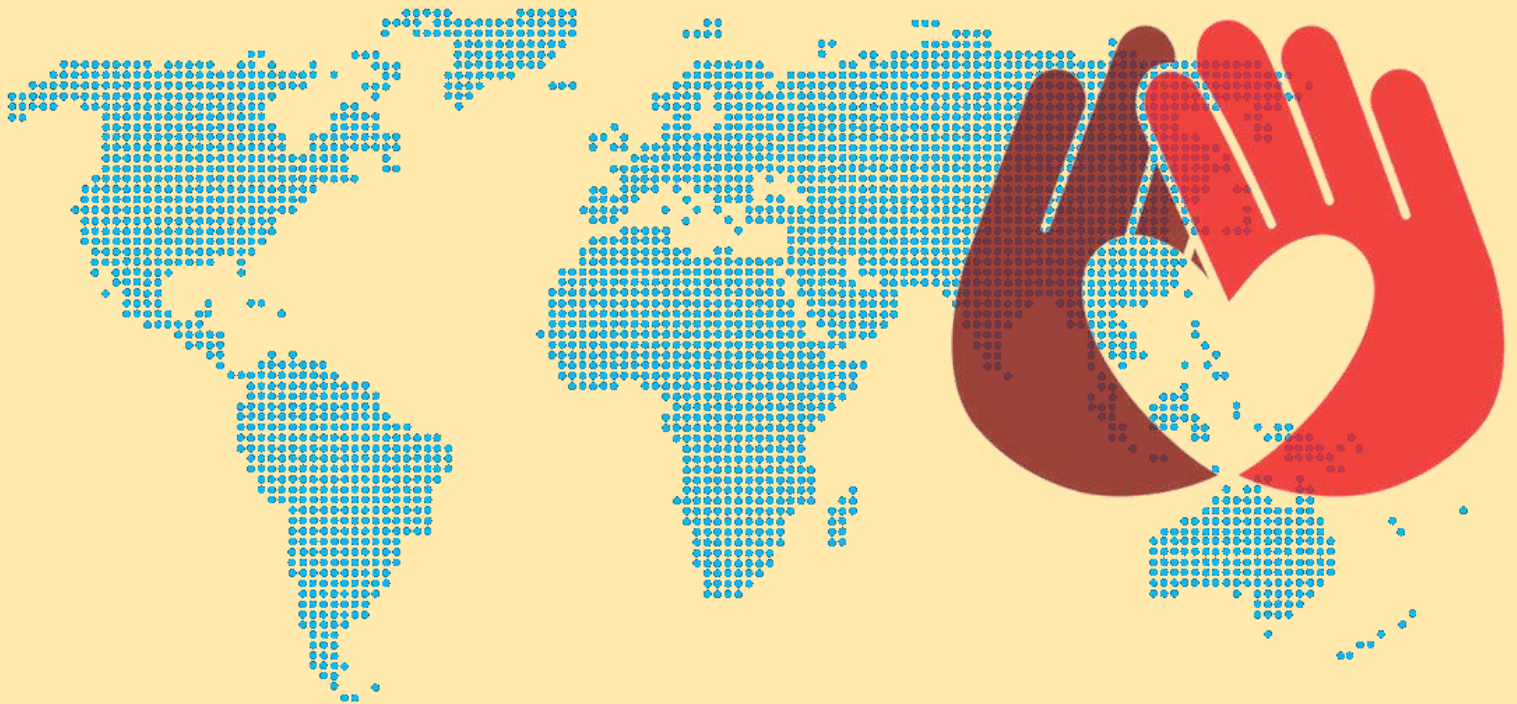
Reviewing: All abstracts will be forwarded for the Scientific Committee's review. If an abstract is accepted, the presenting author must register.
