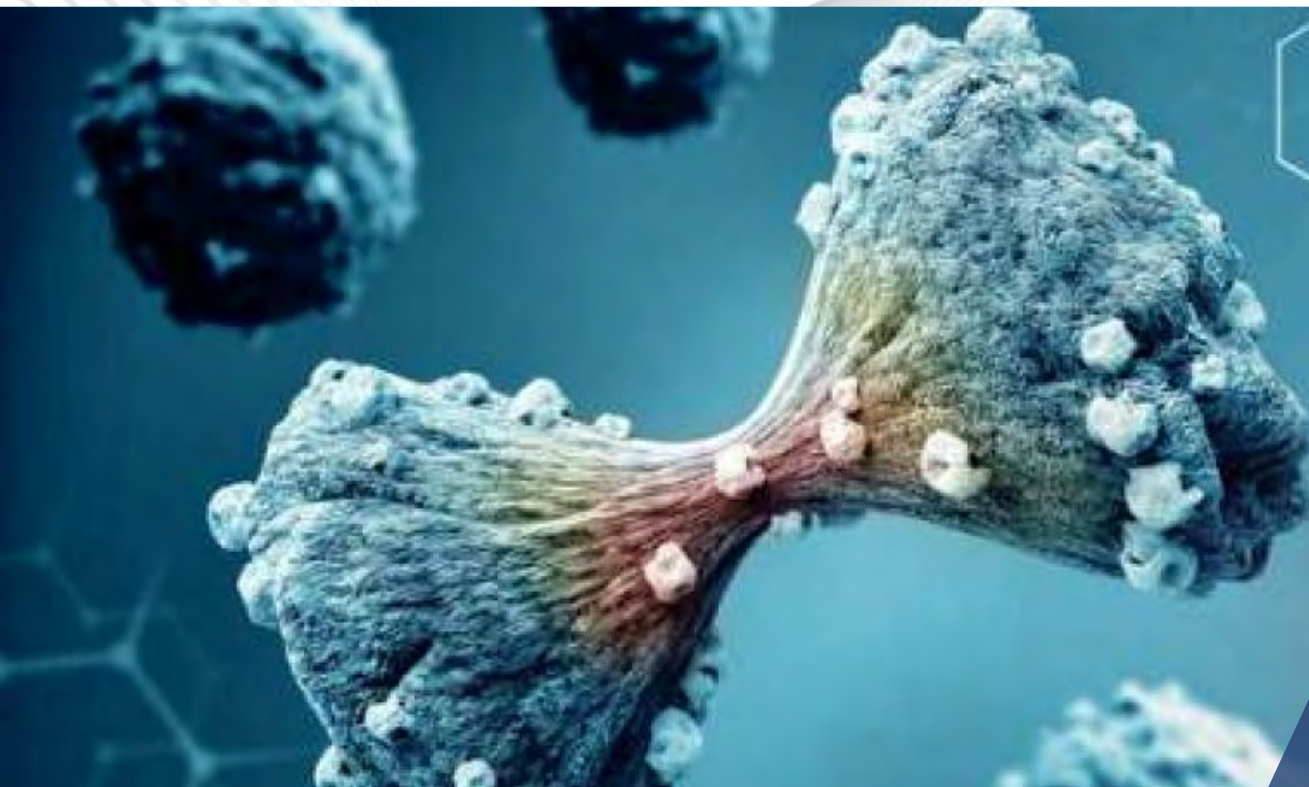

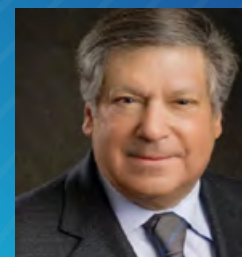

Each and every abstract must be submitted only through the conference website

- Please select the Oral, Poster, or Young Researchers Forum abstract category when submitting your abstract
- Authors should make sure that the submitted abstracts are accurate
- Any typographical errors in the written word or in scientific data shall be published
- You are in charge of making sure that each co-author has given their consent to be listed on the abstract
- Oral presenters who are accepted will speak during the designated session
- Each abstract should start with the presenting author's first name
- The abstract must not exceed 300 words
- Mention the name of the institution where the work was completed
- Abstract's structure; Statement of the Problem, Objective, Methodology, Results, and Conclusion. For case reports: Statement of the Problem, case summary, and conclusions
- Choose the subject from the supplied list
- An acknowledgement email will be sent upon the submission of your abstract
- The notification of abstract status will be sent after 3 days of the abstract submission
- If the abstract doesn't meet the standard requirements, the scientific committee of Cancer Meet-2026 has the right to accept or reject any abstracts without providing a reason
